



On successful login, you will automatically land on the homepage of ProPortal:







Under "My Information and Change Requests" you can navigate through a variety of options including;


**Academic Information** that is populated by your child's tutors and is linked to the markbook. Navigate around the units/assessments/tasks tabs for more detailed information



**Achievement on Entry** are the qualifications your child has achieved prior to attending South Gloucestershire and Stroud College.

**Learner Details** and **Additional Learner Details** are the contact details we hold on the system for your child, Next of Kin information and brief enrolment details.

The **Assessment Schedule** (sample below) are the assessments that your child is expected to complete and is populated by the markbook. If you only want to view incomplete assessments, you can tick here .




**Enrolments** details all courses that your child is enrolled on:



The **Lesson Timetable** provides an overview of your child's timetable.

The final 3 options in the drop down menu, **Detailed Attendance**, **Weekly Attendance** and **Weekly Attendance** Summary give you the choice of how you want to view your child's attendance.

From the "My SGS Progress" tab, your child is expected to complete the section Previous Exam Support and this enables tutors to be able to support your child moving forward – this area records support that your child received at previous education providers.



**My Attendance & Punctuality** provides another overview of attendance, records the number of times your child has been marked as arriving late and the date of last attendance.

**My Targets** will display all targets that have been set by the tutor – it will display whether they have been achieved or not and the relevant due dates.



My Enrichment Activities and My Work Experience / Placement details time spent completing Enrichment and Work Placement activities.

Under the miscellaneous tab you can view **Report To Parents.** Your child will have an updated report at the end of every half term. This report will focus on behaviours and academic progress. They will be scored from 1-5. Please see the key to the score below:

1 - Significantly below standards, 2 - Below SGS standards, 3 - Meeting SGS standards, 4 - Above SGS standards, 5 - Significantly above standards

It is important to note that not all reporting windows will have written feedback, but census points 2 and 4 will have commentary on progress, both from a behaviour and academic progress perspective.
